

Defensible Space Consultation





Defensible space is the 100' feet

around your home. Its divided into three zones for wildfire risk. Our staff will assess these zones and recommend improvements in a report sent directly to you. Homeowners need not be present for the assessment.



Chipping of Woody Material

Homeowners who complete a defensible space consultation are eligible to have woody material chipped. Piles including natural vegetation (limbs, small trees, brush all less than 6" in diameter) will be chipped during the last two weeks of October.
